1. When trying to obtain shots of action, the photographer can use one of two approaches:

- * Follow subject with the camera. Wait for action to happen. This is called 'panning'.
- * Focus the camera on a particular spot where action is anticipated and wait for it to happen.

When panning:

- * Tracking is initiated prior to taking the shot.
- * Squeeze the shutter button to avoid any downward movement of the camera.
- * Track the movement for 1-2 seconds after the shot is taken.

When shooting for a fixed position:

- * Set the aperture manually to cover the expected focal position
- * Use a remote release to activate the shutter.
- * Use a tripod.
